The Clinical Fellowship programme is intended for paediatric endocrinologists in training, with special emphasis on those from countries with limited local training possibilities. Most of the fellowships are offered for the duration of 3 to 6 months. Applications are accepted from all over the world and following the selection process, the applicants are recommended to choose a European centre of excellence for their training.
