We would like to warmly invite applicants for the forthcoming ESPE 2020 Diabetes, Obesity and Metabolism (DOM) School, which will be held in the beautiful region of Cumbria, England, UK. The aims of the DOM School are to provide up-to-date teaching in some selected areas of diabetes, obesity and metabolism, to promote discussions and interactions between young physicians and senior paediatric endocrinologists and to develop future leaders in Paediatric Diabetes, Obesity and Metabolism.

The course will start in the morning of Sunday, 13th September 2020 and will end on Tuesday, 15th September 2020 around lunch time. It will include interactive lectures by experienced ESPE members, with the aim of covering all main topics in diabetes, obesity and metabolism. These lectures will be supplemented by small group sessions to discuss teachers' cases; and case presentations by the students. The course also includes an introduction into clinical research with presentation by students of research proposals and projects in small groups, and presentation of selected work to the plenum.

The event will be held at Laura Ashley Hotel The Belsfield, located on the banks of Lake Windermere (90 minutes drive from Liverpool or Manchester), immediately after the 59th Annual Meeting of the European Society for Paediatric Endocrinology in Liverpool.
