

## **ESPE Summer School 2022**

The 35th ESPE Summer School was held at "Le Tre Vaselle" in the small village of Torgiano (Perugia, Italy) from September 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>, prior to the annual ESPE meeting in Rome.

The Steering Committee developed the programme around four themes focusing on Thyroid disorders, Diabetes & Obesity, Adrenal and gonadal disorders and Bone diseases. These were delivered via a combination of state of the art lectures and interactive cases.

An important feature of the Summer School was the presentation of cases by each fellow that were initially discussed in small groups with the help of a faculty member before being delivered to the whole group. These cases covered an extensive range of challenging endocrine disorders leading to active discussion and interaction between fellows and faculty.

There were 26 delegates from 15 countries and 3 continents.

Social activities consisted of a visit to the Museum of the Wine, in Torgiano and a tour of the medieval town of Assisi.
